SEA REGISTRATION BEGINS

Secondary Schools across the country have begun to register the new intake of students based on the Secondary Entrance Assessment (SEA). Parents and Guardians are advised to bring with them on Registration Day the following:

- Secondary Entrance Assessment Placement Slip
- Student's Birth Certificate (which must carry the same name as the Student's Placement Slip)
- Two recent Passport Size Pictures of the student.

Parents and guardians are reminded that in accordance with the policy of the Ministry of Education, fees are not to be charged for registration. However, for purposes of convenience, students may purchase Report Books, Homework Note books, School Badges, Monograms, Identification Badges/Pins and the like in addition to uniforms, where these are sold at the school.

Registration of SEA students began today (Monday, July 2) at the following schools:

- Rio Claro College
- Speyside High School
- Light and Life Pentecostal High
- Waterloo High School
