TEACHERS' EMPLOYEE SURVEY 2007

A Teachers' Employee Survey to assess the opinion of teachers in Trinidad and Tobago on professional matters is to be initiated later this year by the Ministry of Education. School Principals, Vice Principals, Heads of Departments, Deans, Teachers, Remedial Instructors and Assistant Instructors at Early Childhood Care Centres, Primary and Secondary Schools are to be surveyed.

The survey is important as it will provide the Ministry of Education with valuable insights into the views, attitudes and aspirations of teachers in Trinidad and Tobago. The data, survey results and implications will be used to inform improvements in the teaching learning environment.

As a prelude to the study, groups of teachers from all education districts are being assembled to review the questionnaire, discuss individual and organizational performance management, identify potential problems and solutions associated with the survey and to discuss logistical arrangements for the investigation.

This survey on the opinions of teachers on professional matters forms part of Government's overall programme of surveying opinion throughout the Public Service. The Ministry of Public Administration, Information, and Market & Opinion Research International, a United Kingdom firm contracted to carry out the survey, are coordinating the survey.
