



About Our National Schools' CyberFair



The Ministry of Education's 1st Annual National Schools CyberFair 2007 is a competition which builds on the International CyberFair model. Students will work collaboratively and with community members, conduct research about their local communities and publish a website displaying their findings. Although students are required to publish a website, the emphasis is not on website design but on the quality of content derived from research, the quality of learning experienced and the community relationships developed.

Research will be based on any **one** of the eight categories being judged:

- local leaders or heroes,
- local attractions (natural and man-made)
- historical landmarks,
- environmental awareness and issues,
- local culture, music and art forms
- local specialties, sports and health
- businesses and organisations, and
- community groups and special populations.

Awards will be given for the **four (4)** best projects submitted by primary and secondary schools.
