External and Private Candidates are invited to apply to write the July/August 2021 Level II/III Examinations of the National Examinations Council (NEC).

**Who is an External Candidate?**

- One who previously wrote the NEC final examinations of a particular course as either a Full-Time or Part-Time student.
- One who was successful in some of the subjects of the course and wishes to rewrite the examinations in the outstanding subject(s) not yet passed.

**Who is a Private Candidate?**

One who is at least **18 years** of age and possesses a **minimum 5 years** work experience in the related occupational area, in addition to the following:

**For Craft Courses**

- Level I certification  
**OR**
- Recommendation from a qualified practitioner

**For Diploma and Technician Courses**

- Minimum Level II certification or equivalent

*Note: Private candidate applicants are required to submit documented proof of work experience.*
